Bv Air

Glasgow International Airport is located about 20 minutes from the city centre with frequent domestic and international services. A taxi terminal and airport bus service is located immediately outside the airport building. Prestwick International Airport and Edinburgh International Airport are both less than an hour away from Glasgow City Centre. Prestwick Airport is served by a train line that provides frequent services to and from the city.

By Train

Glasgow is served by two railway stations – Glasgow Queen Street and Glasgow Central

Station. Both are within a 10 to 15 minute walk of the College.

By Car

Glasgow is easy to get to by car although the motorways can get congested during peak times. A number of clearly signposted carparks are accessible and within walking distance of the College. There is a two-hour parking restriction on all city centre streets
